Timothy Aylor is a senior economist in the Economic Information and Analytics unit of the Virginia Employment Commission (VEC). There, he is responsible for producing the employment situation, Job Opening Labor Turnover Survey, and initial claims press releases. He also works on industry and occupational employment projections and produces various economic analysis to clients, staff, and media.

Prior to coming to the VEC, he served as a consulting economist with Economic Modeling Specialist International (now EMSI Burning Glass).

Timothy began his career working as an analyst on the Consumer Price Index and, among other work, conducted hedonic regression analysis on collected price data to better understand how changes in the quality of goods and services affect price. Then, he moved onto become a lead industry analyst working on the Bureau of Economic Analysis' GDP by Industry and Input-Output model programs.
